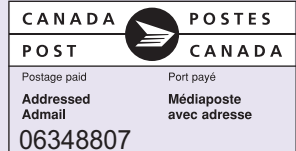

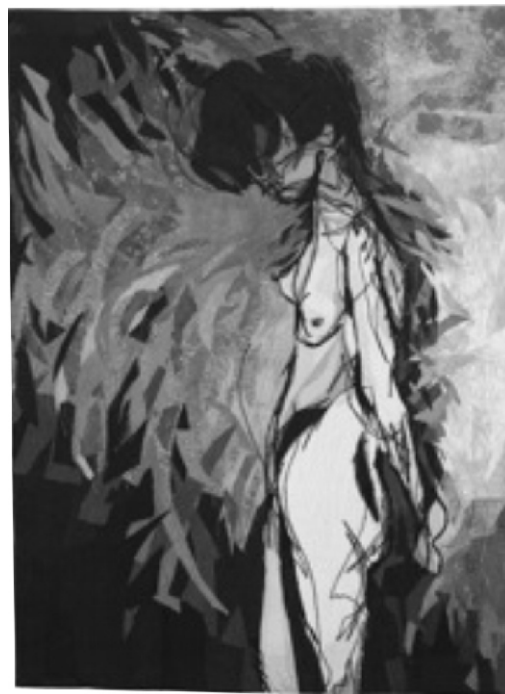

# Special Guest Instructor Jayne Willoughby Scott

Jayne Willoughby Scott was raised in and around Medicine Hat, Alberta. During the 1970's she actively pursued batik and dye painting on fabric. While working as a nurse and nurse educator for 10 years Jayne continuously took painting classes and was an avid knitter and seamstress. As a stay-at-home mom in 1988, she began pursuing art and art quilting seriously with 8 classes from Judy Villet in her Fabrication Studio, Edmonton, Alberta. She joined the sales staff at Earthly Goods in 1989, taught Prime Patch and Seminole Piecing at the High Street location in the early 90's, and developed and taught the Design Fundamentals and Surface Design classes (painting, foiling, machine quilting) from 1998-2005. Jayne has continued to take classes from internationally recognized quilt artists and completed a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in painting, drawing and sculpting from the University of Alberta in 2001. Jayne's stitched textiles have been exhibited nationally and internationally for the past two decades and she has earned numerous awards. Currently, her textile works can be seen in a European traveling exhibition curated by Nancy Crow (Color Improvisations) and in two US traveling exhibitions (Studio Art Quilt Association). The artist lives in Edmonton and continues to exhibit and teach.

How do we stop puckers from happening? Which products to use? Get all the answers to many questions regarding stabilization of fabric with or without a hoop. You will also learn how to make lace as well as other creative stitches to enhance the texture of your work.

Learn to use a variety of stitches to add detail and interest to thread painted motifs. Try feathering and shading. Any zigzag sewing machine will do the job.

Add appliqué details to fabric pictures. 'No Show' for free motion embroidery, straight stitch, raw edge, and free motion techniques. Learn tips and tricks about setting tension. If you have had problems using metallic threads on your machine, your problems will disappear with a few adjustments. We will explore the possibilities of bobbin drawing and couching.

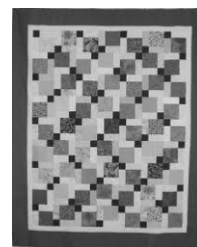




