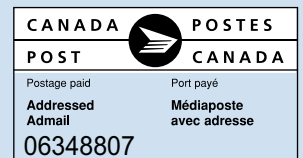

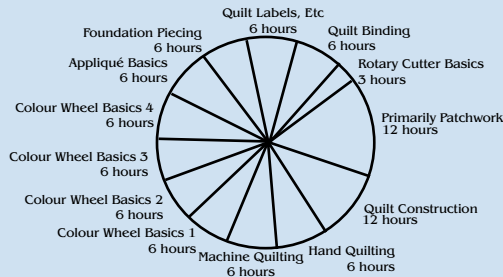

# Quilting by Degree



These in-depth classes provide a total of 87 hours of expert instruction in quilt making basics. Each class taken is recorded into a computer database for each participant. These degrees are kept on file until completion, with no time constraints. After completion of the Quilting by Degree program you are part of the Earthly Goods Alumni. Graduates receive a special pin, are recognized in the newsletter as well as receive a 20% discount (personal use only) in their birthday month each year. Next Alumni meeting is on January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 1 pm – 3 pm or 7 pm – 9 pm. Meeting includes previews of new products, fabrics, presentations, exchanges, show and share.
